Adam Kremin moved to approve the Minutes of the August 1, 2024 meeting. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

The lake level at 7.76. The gate opening was releasing 2.5" cfs.

Payment Authorization

The Commissioners were provided with a list of payables due in September and provided a folder documenting the various amounts. Todd Howe to ratify the payment to Harland Clarke for a reorder of checks in the amount of \$114.03 and to authorize payment to Avista, \$34.57 via scheduled electronic funds transfer (EFT); Twinlow Camp \$100.00; Coeur d'Alene Press \$75.47; for the budget legal ad; Renee Miller, reimbursement of Quickbooks annual software renewal, \$159.80; payroll of \$708.05 net (\$875.00 gross) for August time; and estimated one half premium for ICRMP insurance, \$1,199.50, and estimated State Insurance Fund premium of \$450.00, both due in October. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously. The Commissioners were also presented with a folder containing times sheets and a QuickBooks recap of the August time.

Bank Statements

The Secretary/Treasurer provided the Commissioners with copies of the August bank statements, dated September 2, 2024, and bank reconciliations.

Correspondence Review

The emails received from Kootenai County were the remittance statement showing property tax revenue in the amount of \$1,160.58 in August 2024. Other informational messages were received from Washington Trust Bank, Avista, Rathdrum Chamber of Commerce, Kootenai Office of Emergency Management, ICRMP regarding webinar and insurance renewal, Idaho Department of Water Resources regarding grant approval and emergency action plan, inquiry regarding "East Green Acres Ditch" property, and inquiry from Flood Control District 10 regarding proposed Idaho code changes for 2025 legislature.

Old Business

The commissioners discussed the sandbar project. Information needed to apply for the IDWR grant was not available in time. Adam will work on the permitting applications, which may be lengthy, in anticipation of doing the project next year. The commissioners discussed other possible projects for next year, including the possibility of requesting assistance with additional improvements to the gates by Rubicon. Michelle Richman asked for as built plans from Rubicon and Cooper and completed contract documentation.

New Business

The Commissioners conducted a hearing for the Approval of the Budget for FY 2024-2025.


