The meeting was **called to order** at 6:03 pm by Chairman Todd Howe.

A quorum was established.

Others Attending: Laurin Scarcello, dam operator, and Renee Miller, Secretary/Treasurer.

Janet Armstrong moved to approve the Minutes of the April 2, 2026 meeting. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Lake Level Report

The lake level is at 10.28. The side gate opening was 1/2" releasing 12 cfs.

Adam Kremin moved to ratify the April relinquish of control of the dam to the Twin Lakes Water District 95-C. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously

Payment Authorization

The Commissioners were provided with the payables list for approval and a folder documenting the various amounts. **Adam Kremin moved to authorize the payables due in May and ratify a \$10 payment to the Idaho Tax Commission for payroll taxes that were due April 30 as presented in the amount of \$ 897.11. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.** The Commissioners were also presented with a folder containing time sheets and a QuickBooks recap of the May payroll.

Bank Statements

The Secretary/Treasurer provided the Commissioners with copies of the bank statement and reconciliation of the April account.

Financial Report

The report of financial activity was tabled.

Correspondence Review

The emails received from Kootenai County was a remittance statement showing property tax revenue and request for completion of a form declaring the date of our budget hearing, which was completed and emailed. Other informational messages were from Avista, Rathdrum Chamber of Commerce, ICRMP, Kootenai Emergency Management, the Local Government Registry, the Stevens Connect, and bank newsletter. There was correspondence from tax entities confirming filing and/or payment. An email was received documenting the turnover of control of the dam to the Water District and an invoice from Bigfoot. The USPS mail contained a post card announcement of the annual Twin Lakes Water District 95-C meeting.

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Old Business

Grant Application

The Commissioners discussed the subject area of the grant. There are only two owners of the adjacent property. The waterway at that point is called Willow Creek AKA Canal. The Canal continues under a railroad bridge. One of the property owners allowed All Terrain to stage on his property last year. Renee Miller agreed to seek the letters of support needed. She found a plat map and printed it from the Kootenai Assessor's web site. Photos of the project site should be submitted. Communication to All Terrain is needed to let him know we need his estimate and a certificate of insurance from him before June 5.
